Main objective

·Strengthening and supporting teachers' profession by creating innovative tools aiming to enhance the key abilities and attitudes, necessary for effective implementation of digital learning and proper functioning in the new educational reality.

Other objectives

·To build a strong partnership network of 7 participating organizations in 4 European countries.

·To train teachers in this simple and effective method of acquiring skills based on micro-videos, micro-tasks that will create micro-habits that will become micro-successes.

·To offer support to the education system in the digital transformation of education.

·To develop a training system of learning skills based on practice.

·To promote the results of the project to other institutions that may benefit from its products.

Main Results

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R1 Discovering the way –a research report, aiming to create a map of the 12 most important soft skills needed for effective and successful managing of digital learning process.

R2 Walking in the pathway–a useful and attractive didactic tool aiming to support teachers and educational staff during

the process of acquiring and improving their soft skills, needed for enhancement of their pedagogical work in a digital environment

R3 Skills pathway–a handbook with guidelines for practical application of the research report mapping the 12 crucial digital skills (R1) and the training toolkit for their development (R2)

- ★ 7 participating organizations in 4 European countries
- ★ PRI: Task 1.1. Mapping the 12 most important digital soft skills
- ★ 36 micro-tasks (tasks-box) and 1 self-evaluation tool
- ★ (E1-E4) Multiplier Events with at least 15 stakeholders each event
- ★ (C1) the result will be a training for 14 participants
- ★ 250 people will participate in the project directly while other 100 will directly benefit
- ★ 1000 stakeholders (schools, educational institutions, public organisations, training providers) beyond the EU.
- ★ 3 Project Results in 5 languages (RO, ES, BG, PT and EN)
